

DANIEL LASKY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2016

Applications are now being accepted for the Daniel Lasky Scholarship Fund award.

If you have a son or daughter who will graduate from high school this year and attend an accredited college in the coming Fall term, apply now for the scholarship award. Read the rules, fill out the blank application, and mail it today.

The scholarships are open each year to the children of members of NOITU, under procedures and rules outlined in this announcement. The applicant must be the son, daughter or legally adopted child of a NOITU member. The applicant must also be graduating from high school in 2016 and going on to an accredited college.

The parent of the student-applicant must have at least one-year continuous good standing membership in NOITU as of the date of application for the scholarship and must be working full-time for a company under contract with NOITU.

Scholarships to make possible attainment of a bachelor's degree in the arts and sciences are determined in a competition among eligible applicants to be judged by a Scholarship Committee.

Up to five (5) scholarships will be awarded; however, the scholarship committee reserves the right to award either more or less scholarships depending upon the amount of money available for the awards.

The entry rules are easy and simple: good marks in high school are an asset and often determine who will be the winner, but good grades alone are not the only standard the judges use in making their awards.

EXCLUSIONS

The Scholarships are not available to students already attending or who will already have attended college; to graduate students; to applicants who do not enroll in an accredited college on a full time basis; to children of retired members and officers, delegates or employees of the Union, Trust Fund or the NOITU Individual Account Plan.

APPLICANTS ARE ADVISED

- To obtain guidance in pursuing a college education from their high school counselors.
- Not to wait until awards are made before making other plans for financing their college education.
- To apply early for other grants, scholarships or loans from other sources.
- To make application for admission to at least three colleges.

HOW TO APPLY

Eligible students must use the application form attached, and forward to the Daniel Lasky Scholarship Committee, 148-06 Hillside Avenue, Jamaica, N.Y. 11435.

Applications must be postmarked no later than May 31, 2016. Applications received after this date will not be acknowledged or processed.

All eligible applicants are required to submit the following items in addition to the application form:

1. Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT I) scores.
2. Verification of acceptance by a college or university approved by the Federation of Regional Accrediting commission of Higher Education.
3. Letters of recommendation from (2) faculty members, preferably on high school letterhead, from the high school you are attending.
4. Your high school transcript (showing final grades through the first semester of the Senior Year).
5. The name and address of the college you will be attending.

Deadline for application is **May 31, 2016**. Awards will be made on the basis of scholastic standing and attainment of the individual student, as well as need and other considerations and will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
